



Holy Cross Cemetery – Price List In-Ground Bronze Marker Lots

Located on Governor's Road (Highway 5) in Paris, Holy Cross Cemetery serves the needs of the Catholic community of Brantford and surrounding areas. Holy Cross Cemetery provides a picturesque and tranquil place of rest, and is one of the newer cemeteries operated by The Catholic Cemeteries of the Diocese of Hamilton. Holy Cross Cemetery is also the location of Holy Cross Catholic Cremation Centre and Our Lady of the Assumption Mausoleum.

The cost of a single grave bronze marker lot is **\$1,288.20**. The cost of a two-grave bronze marker lot is **\$2,576.40**. This cost includes HST. In addition, 40% of the purchase price is allocated to the Care and Maintenance fund administered by the Chancellor of the Diocese of Hamilton. The income from this fund is used to maintain the good order and condition of the cemetery.

Interments

In addition to the burial space, there is also a cost for a grave interment. This cost includes digging and backfilling the grave, removal of excess soil, reseeding and fertilizing. This service may be arranged at time of need or pre-arranged in advance. There are several options available for in-ground burial.

Concrete Outer Containers (Grave Liners)

The Catholic Cemeteries of the Diocese of Hamilton utilizes concrete outer containers for all in-ground casket interments. The cemetery provides a standard concrete liner to families at a modest cost. The price includes HST and the use of grave dressings and lowering device. This service may be arranged at time of need or pre-arranged in advance. Liner costs are as follows:
