



Resurrection Cemetery – Price List Section 6

Serving the needs of the Catholic community in Hamilton Mountain, Ancaster and surrounding areas, Resurrection Cemetery provides a beautiful place of rest. Situated on Garner Road just west of Fiddlers Green Road, Resurrection Cemetery is ideally located for those seeking a tranquil resting place while still being close to the city.

Section 6 has several types of lots available. The cost for the lot includes HST. In addition, 40% of the purchase price is allocated the Care and Maintenance fund administered by the Chancellor of the Diocese of Hamilton. The income from this fund is used to maintain the good order and condition of the cemetery. Lot prices are as follows:

Interments

In addition to the burial space, there is also a cost for a grave interment. This cost includes digging and backfilling the grave, removal of excess soil, reseeding and fertilizing. This service may be arranged at time of need or pre-arranged in advance. There are several options available for in-ground burial.

Concrete Outer Containers (Grave Liners)

The Catholic Cemeteries of the Diocese of Hamilton utilizes concrete outer containers for all in-ground casket interments. The cemetery provides a standard concrete liner to families at a modest cost. The price includes HST and the use of grave dressings and lowering device. This service may be arranged at time of need or pre-arranged in advance. Liner costs are as follows:
